<b>Language Domain(s): Expressive</b>	Point to numbers 1-10 when prompted by adult using numbers listed randomly on a piece of paper to demonstrate understanding of number names.  Ex. - Teacher says "Point to the number nine" and the child points to the correct number.	Identify numbers 1-10 using English, Home language, or pointing with adult support and peer models.	Identify numbers 1-10 using English or Home language with adult support and peer models.
	<b>TOPIC-RELATED LANGUAGE:</b> Children at all levels of language development interact with developmentally appropriate words and expressions such as: Number, Show me number _____.
