	Sort up to 10 objects using attributes with teacher prompting and instruction followed by pointing to the correct group when asked to compare the groups. Ex. Ask the child to sort the bears into 2 groups red and blue. Teacher then asks student which group has more.	Sort up to 10 objects using attributes with teacher prompting and instruction followed by identifying the correct group using a word or short statement when asked to compare.	Sort up to 10 objects using attributes with teacher prompting and instruction followed by identifying and describing the correct group when comparing.
