



The Learning Engagement Competencies dimension measures skills that support young children's engagement in the learning process, such as emotional and behavioral regulation, approaches to learning, and physical control of body movements.

The following PA KEI indicators must be scored in order for a Learning Engagement Competencies dimension score to be calculated.
